Momentum IUL offers four index accounts to help grow cash values based on the performance of the S&P 500[®] or Nasdaq-100[®] Index excluding dividends.¹ You may choose to allocate your premiums to one or more of the index accounts, or combine them with allocations to a fixed rate option. The index accounts offer you downside protection while enabling you to capitalize on market growth. Investing in Prudential Momentum IUL's index accounts does not represent a direct investment in an index. Below are the current rates for each option. Rates are subject to change. 1 Yr. S&P 500[®] Capped Indexed Account

Index Growth Cap	10.25%
Participation Rate:	100% guaranteed

If the index return is positive, then the interest rate credited is one year point-to-point to the index return rate until it is capped at the 10.25% cap. When the index return is negative, no interest will be credit to the account.

1 Yr. Nasdaq-100[®] Capped Indexed Account

Index Growth Cap	10.5%
Participation Rate:	100% guaranteed

If the index return is positive, then the interest rate credited is point-to-point to the index return rate until it is capped at the 10.5% cap. When the index return is negative, no interest will be credit to the account.

6 Mo. S&P 500[®] Capped Indexed Account

Index Growth Cap	4.75%
Participation Rate:	100% guaranteed

If the index return is positive, then the interest rate credited is 6 month point-to-point to the index return rate until it is capped at the 4.75% cap. When the index return is negative, no interest will be credited to the account.

Fixed Rate Options

The fixed rate option currently pays 5.00% and is guaranteed never to go below 1%.

¹ Once an index account segment has begun, index rates cannot change for the duration of the segment. Premiums allocated to index accounts are swept into segments on the 15th of each month and must remain in the segment for the duration of the term. Interest is credited based on the change in the S&P 500[®] Index or Nasdaq-100[®] Index (which excludes dividends) for the 6-month or 12-month period beginning at the segment start date to the segment maturity date. No additional fees when money is allocated to the index accounts. Transfers are allowed at the maturity of the segment to any other index account.
