## Maryland training requirement reminder

503NB

Maryland law (COMAR 31.04.15.05) requires insurers to offer training in the recognition and referral of suspicious claims to independent producers who have appointments with a carrier.

Maryland independent producer anti-fraud training must meet the following requirements:

- Address specific aspects of fraud associated with North American's product lines,
- Be at least two hours in duration, and
- Be updated and reviewed every two years.
