factors

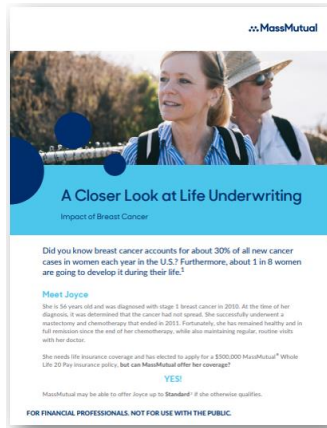
